

# FOLIO 2007 SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

**DEADLINE: Friday, December 8, 2006**

**COVER SHEET:** All work must be accompanied by a cover sheet that looks like this:

To submit your work to Folio magazine, you must be a student (part or full-time) during the 2006-2007 academic year.

**Please submit a separate cover sheet with each genre (poetry, fiction, etc.) you are submitting.**

## **POETRY:**

A student may submit no more than 6 poems for consideration. There must only be 1 poem per page but there is no page limit for the 6 poems. Titles are mandatory for all poems. Please submit 2 copies of each poem typed in 10-point font or greater. No handwritten submissions will be accepted. Please do not put your name on the poems.

## **FICTION:**

A student may submit a maximum of 3 stories totaling no more than 25 pages. Titles are mandatory for all stories. Please submit 2 copies of each story typed in 10-point font or greater. No handwritten submissions will be accepted. Please do not put your name on the stories.

## **CREATIVE NON-FICTION:**

A student may submit a maximum of 2 works of creative non-fiction totaling no more than 20 pages. Titles are mandatory for all creative non-fiction pieces. Research papers and news journalism will not be considered. Please submit 2 copies of each piece typed in 10-point font or greater. No handwritten submissions will be accepted. Please do not put your name on the pieces.

## **ONE-ACT PLAYS:**

A student may submit one work of drama in this category. Only one-act plays will be considered. Titles are mandatory for all one-act plays. Please submit 2 copies of each one-act play typed in 10-point font or greater. No handwritten submissions will be accepted. Please do not put your name on the piece.

## **GRAPHIC NARRATIVE:**

A student may submit one work of graphic narrative. Only black and white work will be eligible for consideration. Please contact the magazine at [folio@southernct.edu](mailto:folio@southernct.edu) to make arrangements for submissions in this category.
